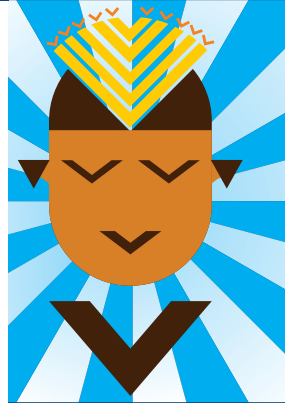
the importance of constantly fighting against evils we encounter in our day to day life, both from within us as well as outside.

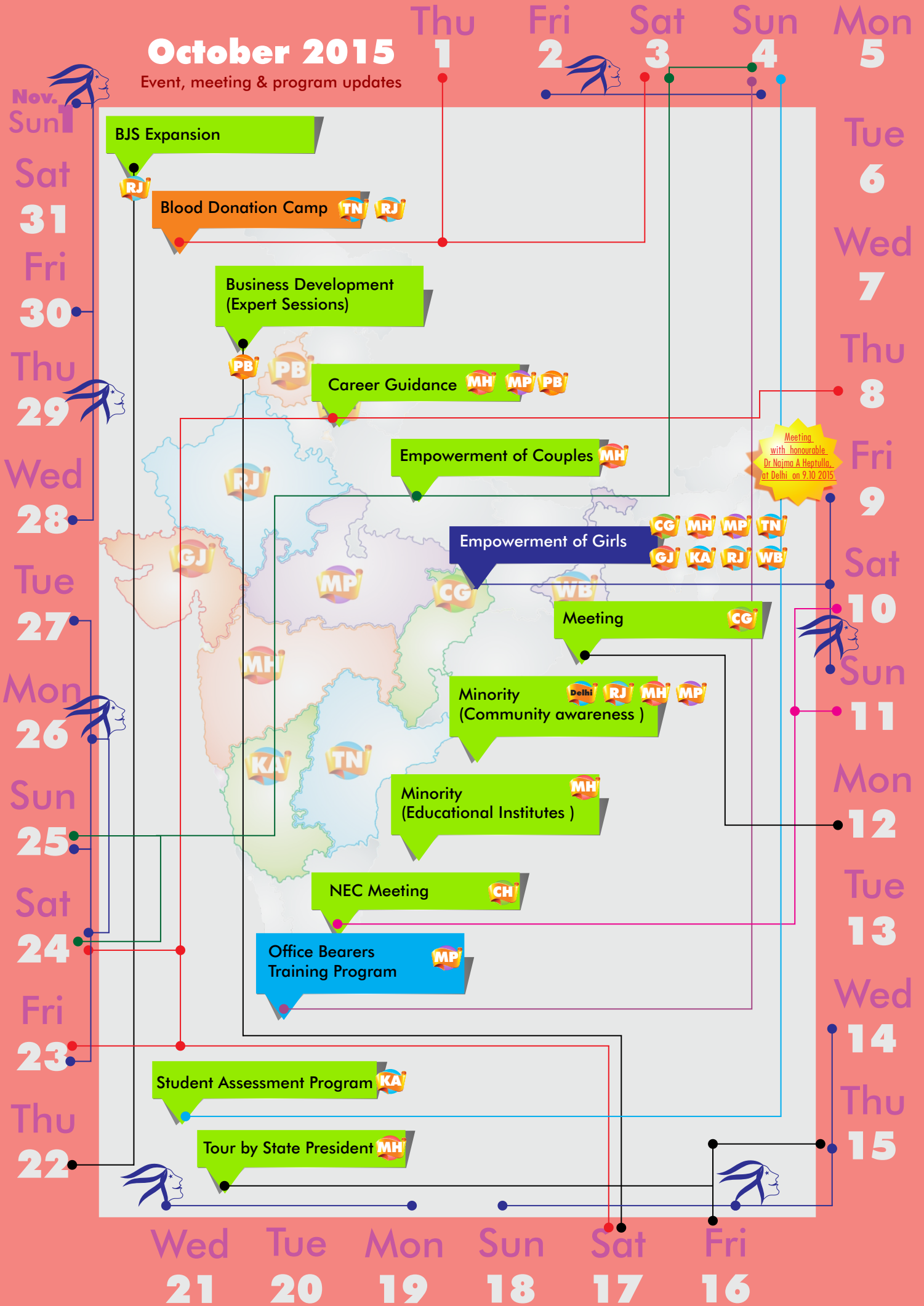
