With great pleasure I present this last issue of the year 2013 that charts the wonderful year-long journey with you. It has been a busy year at BJS. The thrust has been predominantly on some of the big and serious challenges faced by the nation and BJS' response to them.

The year began on a somber note as the nation rocked in anger at the brutal gang rape of a student in Delhi. In response, we vowed 'zero' tolerance to violence, and stepped up a gear on BJS' 'Empowerment of Girls' initiative as a solution.

As summer advanced, around 16 districts of Maharashtra reeled under a dreadful drought caused by poor rainfall and poor water management. We took you through the journey of a challenging month-long campaign of desilting 115 water bodies in Beed district as a mitigation measure, and 100 days in managing 28 cattle-relief camps that were set up for 10,000 animals. I am delighted to say that farmers are now rejoicing as lakes are filled up, thanks to a good monsoon, and the silt spread over the fields is yielding a good crop!

While discussing quality issues in school education including Values Education, key to a better and sustainable world, I introduced you to our 'School Assessment and Accreditation' system, and 'Mulyavardhan' -- the school-based Values Education initiative, both of which have emerged as replicable models and potentially implementable on large scale.

Our dedicated corner on Jain minorities kept you updated about new legislations, scholarships, aid and such information pertaining to the community.

I now look forward to connecting with renewed vigour and enthusiasm- through a redesigned newsletter, social media channels and our BJS Network - with you in 2014.

In closing, let us together in the New Year resolve to "light a candle instead of cursing the darkness." Hope you enjoy this year-end edition. Like always, I look forward to hearing from you.

During the course of the year 2013, our e-bulletin carried a Minority Box. Month after month, we kept you updated about developments, notifications, and benefits on Minorities pertaining to the Jain community. In this year-end edition, we present to you a consolidated inventory of information that will serve as a one-point reference and a ready reckoner.

#### Benefits and information for individuals:

- Doors to minority seat allocation in colleges open if the school leaving certificate states 'Jain' as religion. If the certificate is already issued, attach an affidavit stating 'Religion- Jain'. In Maharashtra, as on November 2013, a self attested letter stating the same is accepted.
- The respective State Commissions for Minorities, announce scholarships for students from Minority Communities in their
- · Students and those self-employed, from the community can avail of financial schemes announced by states that have notified Jains as minority.
- · All Jain students are advised to lookup the websites of their State Commission for Minorities for announcements regularly.

#### Benefits and information for Educational Institutes

- To get a Minority Status for your institute follow the guidelines given at the website: http://ncmei.gov.in/
- In matters of admission of students, minority educational institutions can have reservation of up to 50 per cent for students of their community.
- Schools managed by Minority trusts can select a head master/mistress of their choice and are not bound to select on the basis of seniority only.

### In Maharashtra:

• Institues who wish to apply for the Minority status can now do so online. The link to the facility is:
